ABOUT THE FACILITY

Arenas & Footing

All tests are ridden in 20m x 60m competition arena. Indoor arena is a wood product footing, outdoor arenas are sand. Warm-up: grass field, wood product track and 20m x 60m outdoor arena. Grass longeing area.

Children & Pets

Dogs must be on a leash at all times, and children must be supervised by an adult.

Food

Concessions on grounds during show hours, many fabulous restaurants nearby.

Camping

“Dry” camping is allowed, however generators are prohibited – no hookups; no fires.

Smoking

LOH is a smoke-free facility. No smoking anywhere on the grounds or inside the facility.

Stabling

Stalls must be ordered well in advance; please book early.

All Stalls are solid walled portable 10x10 Chinook stalls with full doors. Fee includes first bedding with shavings; no bedding in tack stalls. Stalls may not be resold or sublet by exhibitors.

AWARDS

Prize for first place and ribbons through 6th place. High point awarded to Junior, Adult Amateur, and Open (Freestyle scores do not count). Class 223 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class.

DIRECTIONS

From the north: I-5 south to Hwy 217 exit (#292); left onto Kruse Way to end. **Right** onto Boones Ferry Road; **right** onto Reese Road; **left** onto Upper Drive. Lake Oswego Hunt is on the **left**, just past the traffic circle.

From the south: I-5 to Lake Oswego Exit (#290). **Right** onto Boones Ferry Road; **right** onto Reese Road; **left** onto Upper Drive. Lake Oswego Hunt is on the **left**, just past the traffic circle.
