The **NANCY WILD MEDAL SERIES** will be judged like the USET Medal Class. Minimum of 3 riders necessary to have rides qualify. Riders will jump a course of at least 8 fences. Top 4 riders (minimum of 2) will return for a work-off determined by the judge. Riders are eligible to ride in the Nancy Wild Medal classes if they are currently competing at the 2'9" level or below. Futures are recognized at the Finals, but do not compete for the custom saddle. Proceeds from the Nancy Wild Medal classes

will be donated to the Providence Cancer Center in memory of LOH's Hunter/Jumper trainer, Nancy Wild. The top 15 qualifiers in Hunter and top 15 in Jumper will compete at the September 22, 2012 in the Medal Finals for a custom saddle from County Saddlery.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Concessions available for snacks, dinner and drinks. Dogs must be on a short leash and will have to leave if not well behaved. Dogs are not allowed in the concessions area. Horses must be current on vaccinations & deworming. Lake Oswego Hunt is a smoke-free facility.

TRAILER FRIENDLY DIRECTIONS TO LOH

NOTE: Mapquest or Google might direct you in a different way that is slightly shorter.

However, the directions below are easier with a horse trailer. Be sure to enter LOH from Iron Mountain Blvd.

1. From I-5, take Exit 292, OR-217/Kruse Way towards Lake Oswego.
2. Follow Kruse Way into Lake Oswego. Go through several stop lights.
3. Kruse Way ends at Boones Ferry. Turn left on Boones Ferry at the light there.
4. Go through one stop light and then veer right at the 2nd intersection on to Country Club Rd. You will pass LO High School on your left and Junior High on your right.
5. Stay on Country Club for about 1.4 miles. At the 5-way stop sign intersection (golf course right there), turn right onto Iron Mountain Blvd.
6. At the next stop sign, turn right (you'll again be turning onto Iron Mountain Blvd.)
7. Continue on Iron Mtn. Blvd for about 1.5 miles. You will pass Oswego Lake Country Club on your right and LOH is about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile further. LOH is on the right hand side; big white barn. **Trailer parking to the right. Please take care not to block others. If you need assistance, pull in and one of our staff can assist you after you have unloaded.**
